



Announcement

on the expenses related to filing suit and their impact on the results

With regards to the announcement made on September 21, 2012, we are releasing the following information.

In relation to the suit filed against AMRI Hungary Zrt. „végelszámolás alatt” (“under voluntary winding up”) arising out of the termination of its lease and payment of lease fees, we estimate the direct and indirect costs to amount to 200 thousand EUR, which amount is not expected to be recovered through 2012.

In accordance with the Half-year Report released on August 6, 2012, we are not altering the revenue forecast for 2012, but the expenses related to the suit were not considered at the time of making the report. To account for this, the forecasted net profit for 2012 has been lowered to 1.5 million EUR from 1.7 million EUR. Revenue forecasts for 2013 will be first published in our Quarterly Report for the third quarter to be released on November 5, 2012.

In accordance with our previous Quarterly Reports, and not altering our conservative estimation methods, in our forecasts (1) any revenues from recovery will not be considered until the final settlement of the claim – this is because the time of settling the case and the actual amount of recovery cannot be estimated reliably –, however, (2) all actual and expected expenses related to realizing the claim will be considered in the forecasts, even though those are expected to be recovered at the closing of the case.
